# BUSINESS ACADEMY COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS

A business-focused approach to completing 24 credit hours of undergraduate coursework toward a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. The Business Academy is offered **ENTIRELY ONLINE**, making it convenient to add the courses to your normal high school schedule.



#### You Could Be Eligible for \$5,000 in Scholarships!

All high school students in the Class of 2024 and beyond who are enrolled in the College Credit Plus program at AU and who matriculate directly from high school into a bachelor's program will receive a \$1,000 scholarship (\$500 to be awarded in the fall semester and \$500 in the spring semester). This scholarship is renewable each year (for up to four years or \$4,000), and is stackable upon other scholarships/aid.

If, as a student in the CCP Business Academy, you complete 12 credit hours from the courses below and matriculate directly from high school into the AU College of Business and Economics, you will receive an additional one-time scholarship of \$500. Alternatively, if you complete 24 credit hours and matriculate directly from high school into the AU College of Business and Economics, you will receive a one-time scholarship of \$1,000. That means you could earn a total of \$5,000 in scholarships to attend Ashland University!

Total institutional aid may not exceed total tuition, room and board costs. Please contact the Financial Aid Office for details.
